Inquiry into the roles, if any, of the GCSB and the NZSIS in relation to certain specific events in Afghanistan: Indicative timeline

The Afghanistan Inquiry being undertaken by the Inspector-General of Intelligence and Security (IGIS), is anticipated to proceed over a similar timeframe to that of the Government Inquiry into Operation Burnham (that Inquiry notifies its timing and process in the Minutes published on its website <https://operationburnham.inquiry.govt.nz>). In light of the public interest in both Inquiries, the IGIS provides the following indicative timeline for information. It will be updated as required.
