Inquiry into the roles, if any, of the GCSB and the NZSIS in relation to certain specific events in Afghanistan: Terms of reference

- A. What, if anything, was the knowledge, awareness and contribution of the GCSB and the NZSIS to the New Zealand Defence Force (NZDF) operations in Afghanistan in relation to events on 3 August 2010 in Bamiyan Province, on 22 August 2010 in Baghlan Province, and in relation to these events over subsequent days?
- B. If the GCSB and the NZSIS played any role, how did these agencies consider and apply New Zealand's human rights obligations to any information collected and/or received about the capture and detention of any individuals in relation to term of reference A?
- C. During the period 2009 to 2013, how did the GCSB and the NZSIS consider and apply New Zealand's human rights obligations to relationships, if any, with detaining authorities in Afghanistan?
- D. If the GCSB and the NZSIS played any role, did these agencies take any steps as a result of the report by the United Nations Assistance Mission in Afghanistan (UNAMA) and the United Nations Office of the High Commissioner of Human Rights in October 2011, on the treatment of conflict-related detainees in custody in Afghanistan (and subsequent UNAMA reports on the same topic)?
